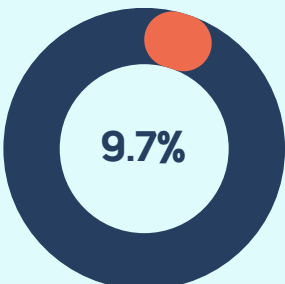

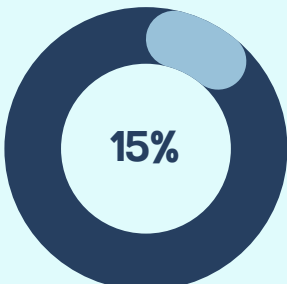
2,555 reports were received in January 2026,
and 16,784 reports were received to date for the current school year.



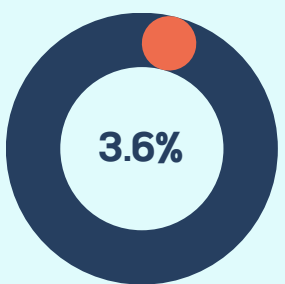
JANUARY REPORT TYPES

Report Example

A report was made about a student posting AI-generated images of peers online that were inappropriate. The school investigated, instructed the student to remove the images, notified parents, and issued disciplinary action.

Duplicate Reports this SY

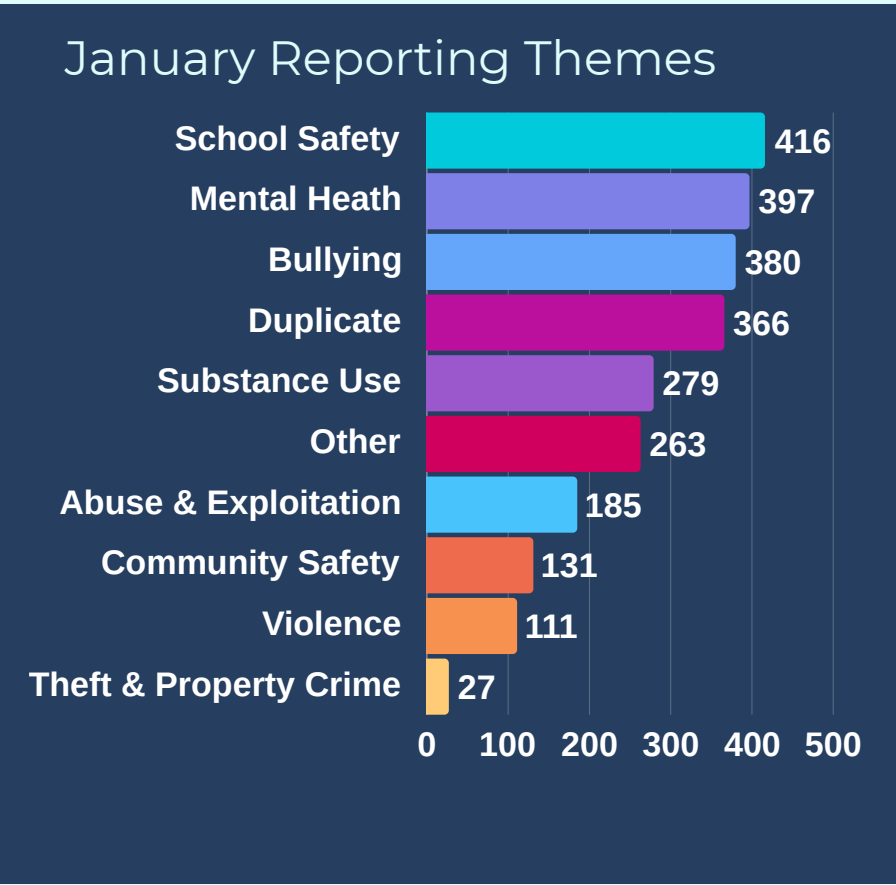


2,890 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

Valid reports during this SY



97.8% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 0.7%, and false reports were 1.5%



Report Example

A report indicated a student was experiencing abuse at home, arriving at school with bruises, and expressing thoughts of self-harm. The student's parents and the Department of Human Services were notified. The student is now receiving counseling services.
