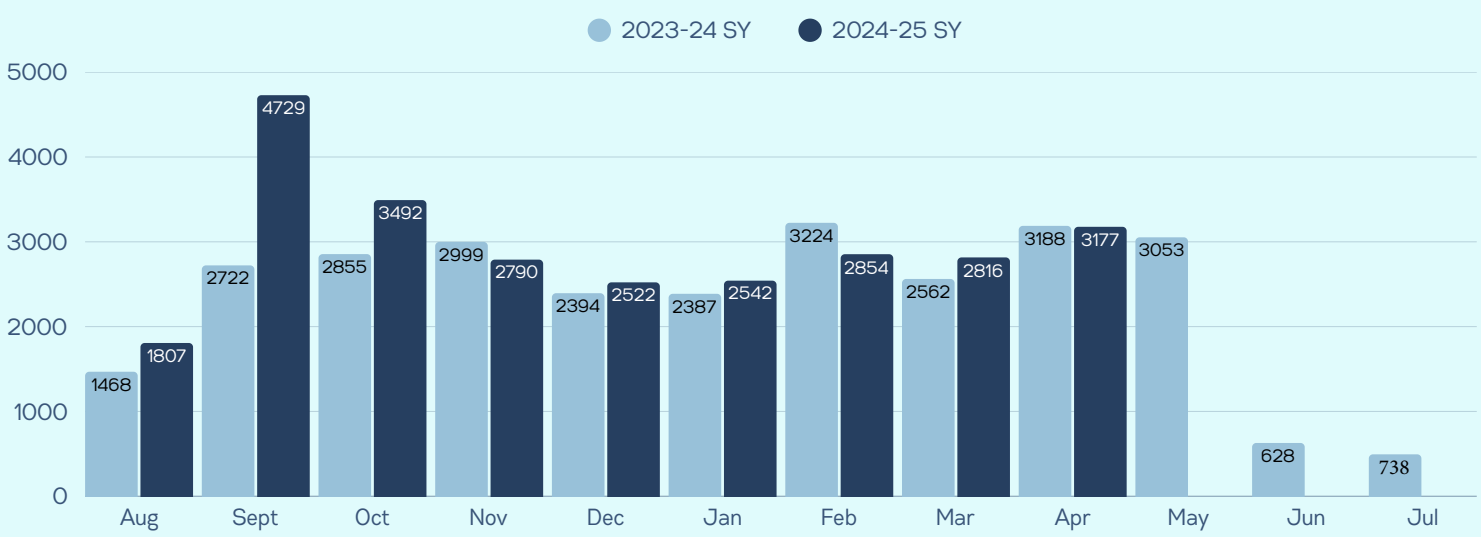

3,177 reports were received in April 2025, and 26,729 reports were received to date for the current school year.

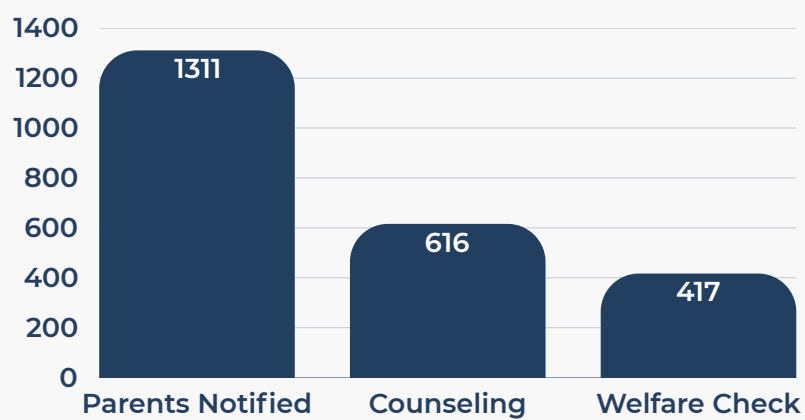

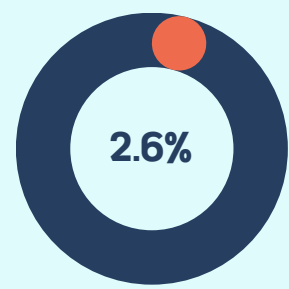

Report Example

A person reported a student expressed wanting to engage in sexual activities with other students and mentioned how they could use drugs to get other students to do what they wanted. School teams investigated and had a restorative conversation with the student, who is now on a safety plan. School officials took disciplinary action and notified the student's parents.

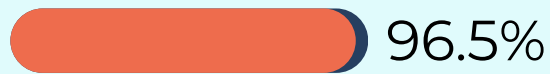


Duplicate Reports this SY



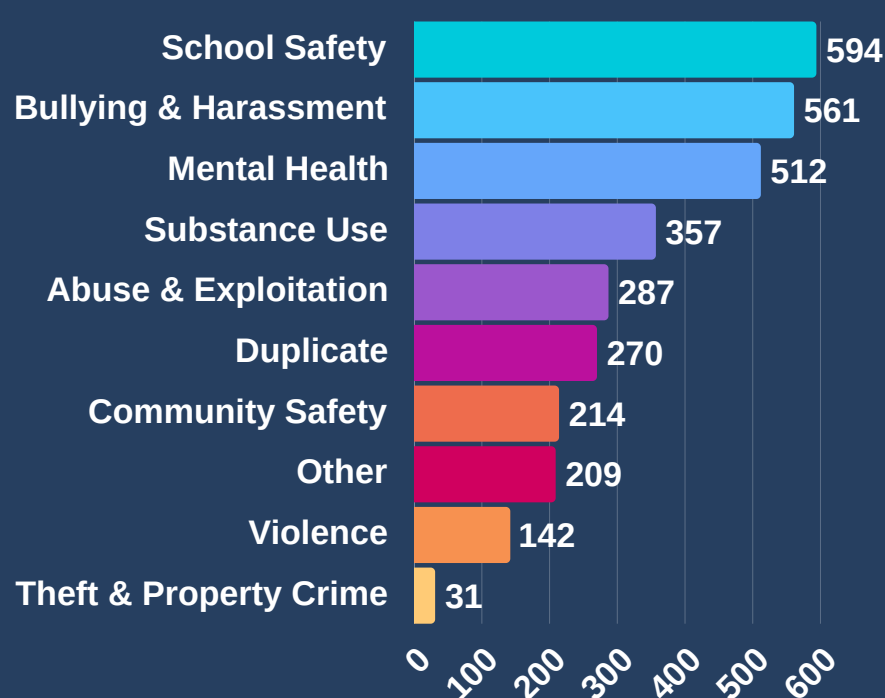
3,532 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

96.5% of reports received during the 24-25 school year, which began 8/1/24, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 1.3%, and false reports were 2.2%

April Reporting Themes



Report Example

A person reported a student posted videos of themselves drinking and vaping at school. School teams investigated and confirmed that the student posted the alleged videos on and off school grounds. The school performed a welfare check, contacted the student's parents, and placed them on a safety plan. The student will also receive counseling services.
