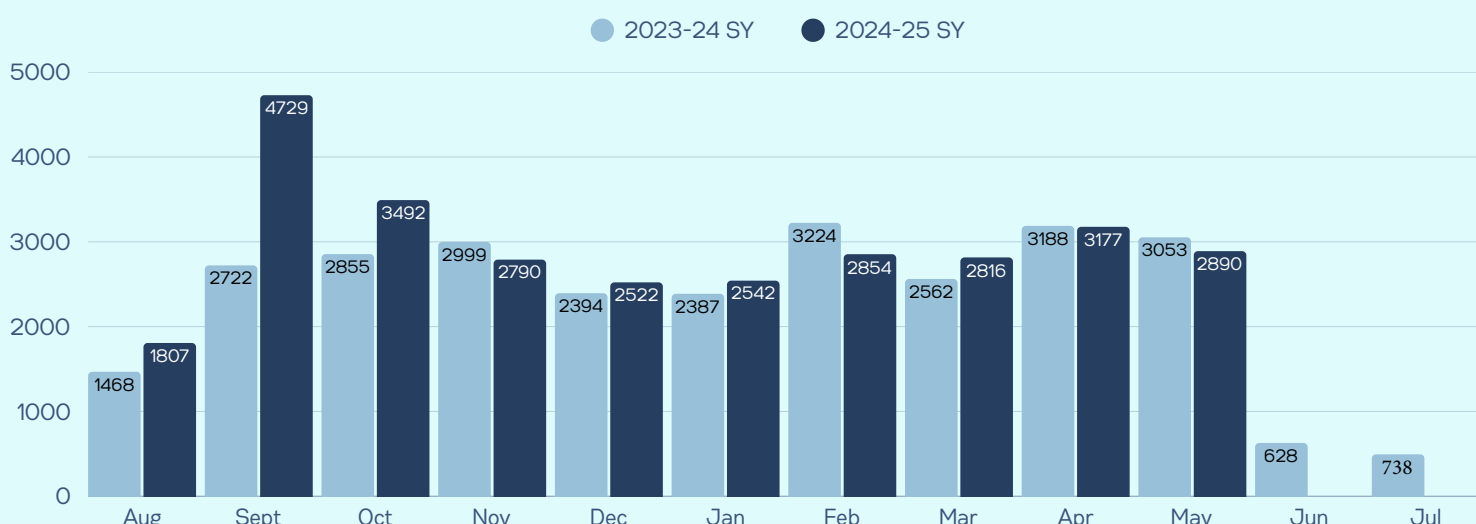

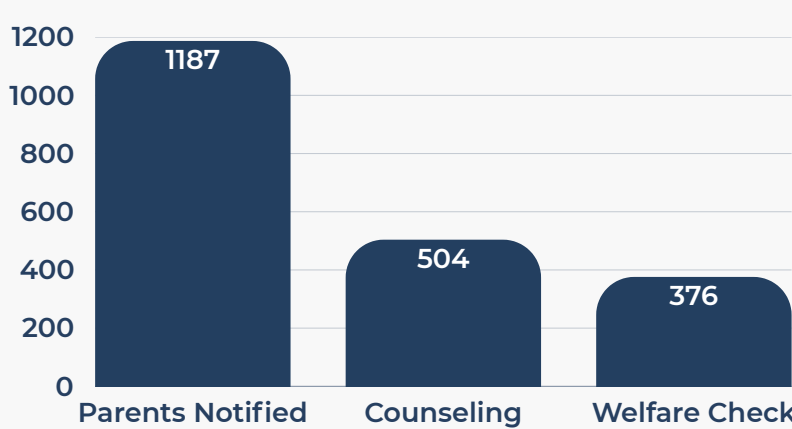


2,890 reports were received in May 2025, and 29,619 reports were received to date for the current school year.

Top Report Categories

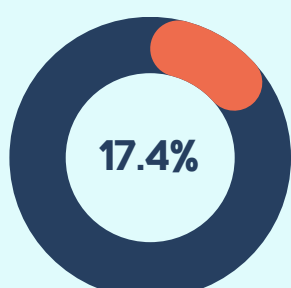
- School Safety Concern: Staff - 333

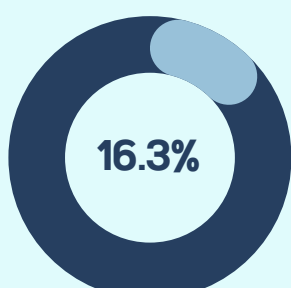

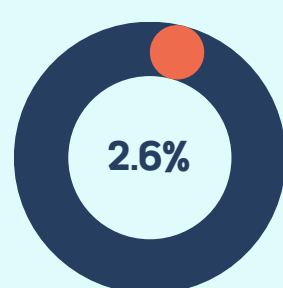

A person reported that a staff member made inappropriate remarks to students and was having sexual relations with them. District officials placed the staff member on leave while doing an internal investigation, which later resulted in the staff member being arrested.

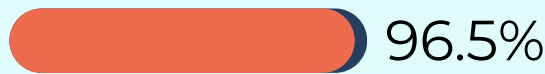


Duplicate Reports this SY



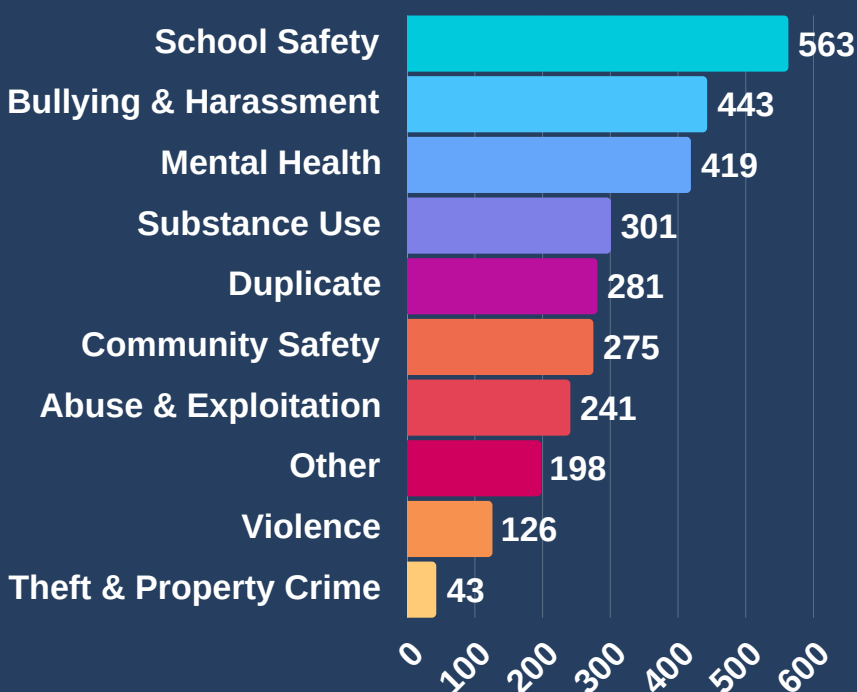
3,822 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

96.5% of reports received during the 24-25 school year, which began 8/1/24, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 1.3%, and false reports were 2.2%

Report Example

A person reported a student was selling vapes to other students at school. School teams investigated, searched the student's belongings and found the student was in possession of vapes. The school notified the student's parents and took disciplinary action.
