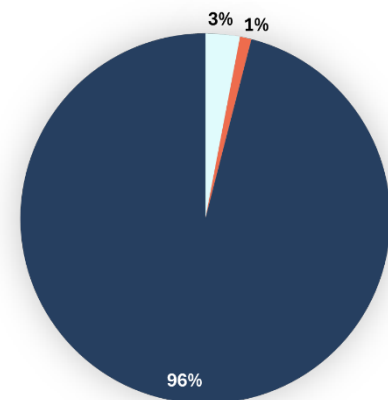
FOUNDING PRINCIPLES

Safe2Tell was developed with the following principles.

- Safe2Tell wants to **educate** the community on the importance of reporting safety concerns, break the code of silence, and provide a trusted way for young people to anonymously make reports about things they may see or hear.
- Safe2Tell's goal is to **encourage** everyone to play a role in prevention.
- Safe2Tell wants to **equip** our community with a direct way to report concerns anonymously.
- Safe2Tell **empowers** those who have the intention to help, prevent, or protect to make a difference.

We know that students often know about mental health concerns or safety concerns about their peers before adults do. We encourage students to be advocates for their community and be part of keeping everyone safe. Safe2Tell always encourages students to talk to a trusted adult first when they have concerns. However, we know it isn't always easy for students to speak up. Safe2Tell is a resource that was created to provide an anonymous way for students to make reports any time, any day.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO NOTE

- Safe2Tell cannot notify the reporting party of the report outcome due to the anonymity of the program. All outcome information is private, and state statute



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protects Safe2Tell report materials.

- If you have previously reported the situation to your school staff and are not satisfied with the outcome, Safe2Tell is not able to enforce a different outcome. Please find the venue within your school district for escalating these concerns.
- Safe2Tell reports are not part of a student's academic record.

LIFECYCLE OF A REPORT

1. Concerned party makes a report via web, mobile app, phone, or text code.
2. Safe2Tell Analyst receives the report.
3. Safe2Tell analysts engage in two-way dialogue to obtain additional information.
4. The report is sent to recipients for the associated school and law enforcement.
5. Contents within a report determines who responds to and addresses the report.
6. Reports are closed by the responding party i.e. associated school or law enforcement.
