## 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR



### NUMBER OF TIPS RECEIVED

**1,069**

1,609 tips were received from September 1 through 30, 2020. This is a **60% decrease** in tip volume from September 2019.

**1,785**

1,785 tips were received from August 1, 2020 through September 30, 2020. This is a **57% decrease** compared to last school year and is related to delayed school openings and distance learning practices due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Approximately 1.7% of tips received during the 2020-2021 school year, which began August 1, 2020, were determined to be false. False tips are reports made with the intent to bully, injure, or harm another person.

### DUPLICATE TIPS

Duplicate tips are reports made regarding a concern or event that has already been reported and are an indicator of a healthy reporting culture within a community. **148 duplicate tips have been reported during the current school year.**
