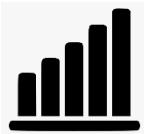
### NUMBER OF REPORTS RECEIVED

2.1% of reports received during the 2021-2022 school year, which began August 1, 2021, were determined to be false. False reports are those made with the intent to bully, injure, or harm another person.

**TOTAL REPORTS RECEIVED SINCE 2004**

Safe2Tell has received 119,199 reports since its inception in 2004. This number excludes duplicate reports, pranks, hang-ups, and test reports.

**DUPLICATE REPORTS**

Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported. **1,875 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year**; 131 duplicates were reported in April alone—a 16% increase compared to March.
