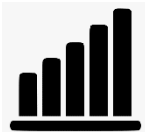
NUMBER OF REPORTS RECEIVED

2.1% of reports received during the 2021-2022 school year, which began August 1, 2021, were determined to be false. False reports are those made with the intent to bully, injure, or harm another person.

TOTAL REPORTS RECEIVED SINCE 2004

Safe2Tell has received 108,465 reports since its inception in 2004. This number excludes duplicate reports, pranks, hang-ups, and test reports.

DUPLICATE REPORTS

Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported. **2,041 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year**; 165 duplicates were reported in May alone—a 25% increase compared to April.
