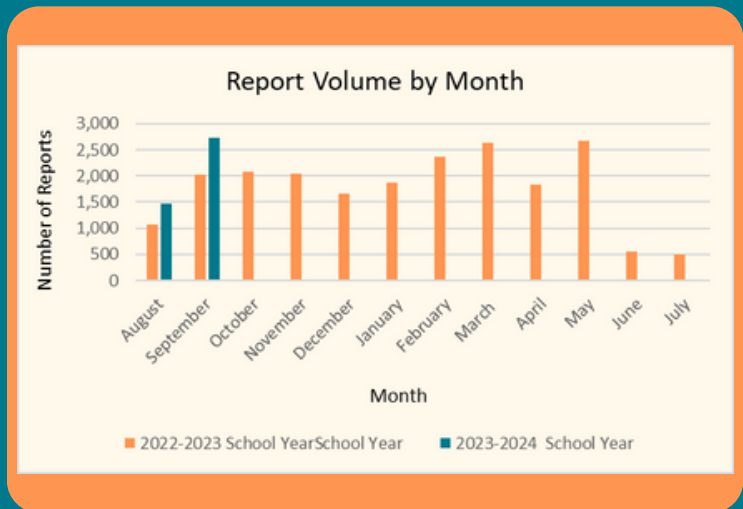

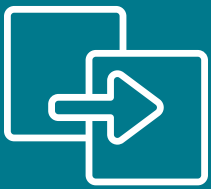

Duplicate reports



Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 331 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year; 221 duplicates were reported in September alone—a 101% increase compared to August.

96% Valid reports



96% of reports received during the 2023-2024 school year, which began August 1, 2023, were determined to be valid. Valid reports are those requiring a response, and that are made with the intent to protect, prevent harm, or help.

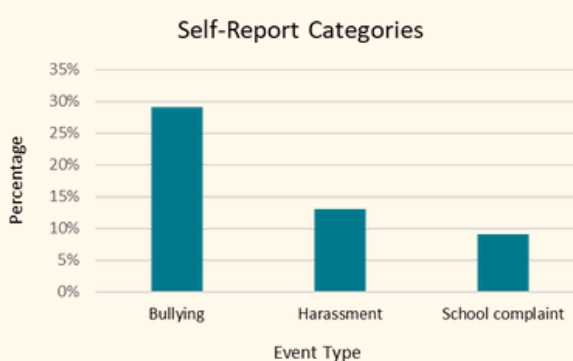
Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student expressed they were struggling with their mental health and wanted to be hospitalized. Local teams conducted a welfare check and spoke with the student's parent. The hospital admitted the student, and local teams conducted a suicide assessment. As a result, the student is now on a safety plan.

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported their concerns about a student's wellbeing and safety at home. Local team investigated and spoke with the student, which led to DHS involvement.
