
#### Duplicate reports

Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 146 duplicates were reported in August alone—a 12% increase compared to July.

## 95.1% Valid reports



95.1% of reports received during the 2024-2025 school year, which began August 1, 2024, were determined to be valid. Valid reports are those requiring a response, and that are made with the intent to protect, prevent harm, or help.

# Sample reports

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student did not feel safe going home and expressed discomfort at being around their guardian. After speaking with the student, the school team concluded they should contact DHS. The school psychologist will also check in on the student.

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported that a student and their family have been victims of gun violence, have access to guns in their home, and that the family needs help. School teams contacted the family, will meet with the student to connect them with the school psychologist to conduct a threat assessment, and have a security guard at school.
